- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 127, Election Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 127.010 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 127.010. FEASIBILITY STUDY ON CENTRAL COUNTING STATION
- 9 OPERATING AS SENSITIVE COMPARTMENTED INFORMATION FACILITY. (a)
- 10 The secretary of state shall conduct a study to consider the
- 11 feasibility of conforming each central counting station with the
- 12 <u>Sensitive Compartmented Information Facilities (SCIF) standards</u>
- 13 promulgated by the United States federal government.
- 14 (b) The study must consider the feasibility of ensuring
- 15 substantial compliance with the SCIF standards while allowing for
- 16 poll watching and other citizen involvement in an election
- 17 permitted under state law.

- (c) Not later than September 1, 2024, the secretary of state
- 19 shall create a detailed report summarizing the findings of the
- 20 study and deliver the report to the legislature.
- 21 (d) This section expires December 1, 2024.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
