1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 659.015(k), Government Code, is amended  
 1-22 to read as follows:

1-23 (k) Compensatory time off to which an employee of [~~a~~  
 1-24 ~~correctional officer employed by~~] the Texas Department of Criminal  
 1-25 Justice is entitled under Subsection (f) must be taken during the  
 1-26 24-month period following the end of the workweek in which the  
 1-27 compensatory time was accrued or it lapses.

1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
