5	SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 49, Water Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 49.240 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 49.240. COUNTY APPROVAL FOR CERTAIN DISTRICTS. (a)
8	This section applies only to a district that is located in a county
9	with:
10	(1) a population of 100,000 or more; and
11	(2) a total area that is less than 250 square miles.
12	(b) A district must obtain the written approval of the
13	commissioners court of the county in which the district is located
14	before:
15	(1) issuing bonds for a district improvement project;
16	<u>or</u>
17	(2) finalizing the plans and specifications for a
18	district improvement project that is:
19	(A) financed by bonds; or
20	(B) related to:
21	(i) the use of land outside the corporate
22	limits of a municipality;
23	(ii) an easement granted by the county; or
24	(iii) a right-of-way of a road or highway.

1 SECTION 2. Section 49.240, Water Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a district, as defined by Section 49.001, Water 2 Code, that issues bonds or finalizes plans and specifications for 3 4 an improvement project on or after the effective date of this Act. A district that issues bonds or finalizes plans and specifications 5 6 for an improvement project before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date 7 8 of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
