2 SECTION 2. Section 2254.1038(b), Government Code, as 3 amended by this Act, applies only to a contract filed on or after 4 the effective date of this Act. A contract filed before the 5 effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed 6 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is 7 continued in effect for that purpose.
