A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to supplemental pay for members of the Texas military
- 3 forces suffering an economic hardship as a result of serving on
- 4 military duty.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Sections 437.220(a), (b), and (c), Government
- 7 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) A person who is called to military duty as a member of
- 9 the Texas military forces [National Guard] in the service of this
- 10 state or the United States by proper federal or state authority and
- 11 who suffers an economic hardship as a result of serving on military
- 12 duty is eligible to receive supplemental pay for serving in
- 13 accordance with this section. Payment under this subsection is
- 14 subject to the availability of funds.
- 15 (b) The comptroller shall establish the Texas military
- 16 forces [National Guard members'] supplemental military duty pay
- 17 account in the general revenue fund. Money in the account may be
- 18 appropriated only for purposes of implementing this section. The
- 19 comptroller, governor, or adjutant general may accept gifts and
- 20 grants for deposit to the credit of the account. The legislature
- 21 may transfer money into the account or may appropriate money to
- 22 implement this section and the comptroller shall credit that money
- 23 to the account.
- 24 (c) A member of the Texas military forces [National Guard]

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- 1 described by Subsection (a) is eligible to receive supplemental pay
- 2 under this section in an amount not to exceed the lesser of:
- 3 (1) the amount required to alleviate the economic
- 4 hardship the member suffers as a result of serving on active duty;
- 5 and
- 6 (2) the difference between the amount of income that
- 7 the member has lost from civilian employment as a result of being
- 8 called to military duty and the amount of military pay and
- 9 allowances the member receives from state or federal sources while
- 10 on military duty.
- 11 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to
- 12 military duty by a member of the Texas military forces occurring on
- 13 or after the effective date of this Act regardless of the date the
- 14 member was called to military duty. Military duty occurring before
- 15 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on
- 16 the date the military duty occurred, and the former law is continued
- 17 in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
