A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the regulation of massage therapy. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 455.001, Occupations Code, is amended by 4 5 amending Subdivision (8) and adding Subdivision (14) to read as 6 follows: 7 "Massage therapy" means the manipulation of soft (8) tissue by hand or through a mechanical or electrical apparatus for 8 the purpose of body massage and includes effleurage (stroking), 9 petrissage (kneading), tapotement (percussion), compression, 10 vibration, friction, nerve strokes, reflexology, and Swedish 11 12 gymnastics. The terms "massage," "therapeutic massage," "massage technology," "myotherapy," "body massage," "body rub," or any 13 14 derivation of those terms are synonyms for "massage therapy." (14) "Reflexology" means the application of pressure 15 to areas on a person's hands, feet, or head for the purpose of 16 relieving tension or stress throughout the person's body. 17 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
