The 17 corporation may charge a reasonable fee for preparing a copy of a record or report. 18 (c) A corporation is exempt from Subsection (b) if: 19 (1) an independent certified public accountant has 20 conducted an audit of the corporation's financial statements for 21 the preceding fiscal year in accordance with generally accepted 22 23 auditing standards; and 24 (2) subject to Subsection (d), the corporation makes

2	corporation's financial activity kept under Subsection (a)
3	available to the public for inspection and copying at the

5	business hours. The corporation may charge a reasonable fee for

7	(d) A corporation shall make an audited financial statement
8	described by Subsection (c)(1) available to the public for
9	inspection and copying not later than the 180th day after the close
