BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 22.353, Business Organizations Code, is 1-25 amended to read as follows:

Sec. 22.353. AVAILABILITY OF FINANCIAL INFORMATION FOR PUBLIC INSPECTION. (a) A corporation shall keep <u>each document the</u> corporation is required to make available for public inspection as 1-26 1-27 1-28 1-29 an entity that is exempt from income taxation under Section 501(a), Internal Revenue Code of 1986, by being listed as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of that code, [records, books, and annual reports of the corporation's financial activity] at the 1-30 1-31 1-32 and annual reports of the corporation's financial activity] at the corporation's registered or principal office in this state for at 1-33 least three years after the close of the fiscal year. 1-34
