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## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to teacher literacy achievement academies and the requirement for certain public school teachers and principals to 3 attend a teacher literacy achievement academy. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Section 21.4552, Education Code, is amended by 7 adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows: (d-1) The commissioner is required to implement a provision 8 9 of this section only if the legislature appropriates money specifically for that purpose. If the legislature does not 10 appropriate money specifically for that purpose, the commissioner 11 12 may, but is not required to, implement a provision of this section using other appropriations available for that purpose. 13 14 SECTION 2. Section 28.006(g-1), Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 15 (g-1) A school district shall provide additional reading 16 instruction and intervention to each student in seventh grade 17 assessed under Subsection (c-1), as appropriate to improve the 18 student's reading skills in the relevant areas identified through 19 the assessment instrument. Training and support for activities 20 21 required by this subsection shall be provided by regional education service centers and any teacher literacy achievement academies made 22 23 available [established] under Section 21.4552, and may be provided

24 by other public and private providers.

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SECTION 3. Section 28.0062(a), Education Code, is amended
to read as follows:

3 (a) Each school district and open-enrollment charter school
4 shall:

5 (1) provide for the use of a phonics curriculum that 6 uses systematic direct instruction in kindergarten through third 7 grade to ensure all students obtain necessary early literacy 8 skills;

if the commissioner has made available teacher 9 (2) literacy achievement academies under Section 21.4552, ensure that: 10 [not later than the 2022-2023 school year,] 11 (A) 12 each classroom teacher in kindergarten or first, second, or third grade and each principal at a campus with kindergarten or first, 13 14 second, or third grade has attended a teacher literacy achievement 15 academy [developed under Section 21.4552]; and

(B) each classroom teacher and each principal initially employed in a grade level or at a campus described by Paragraph (A) [for the 2022-2023 school year or a subsequent school year] has attended a teacher literacy achievement academy [developed under Section 21.4552] by the end of the teacher's or principal's first year of placement in that grade level or campus; and

(3) certify to the agency that the district or school:
 (A) prioritizes placement of highly effective
 teachers in kindergarten through second grade; and

(B) has integrated reading instruments used todiagnose reading development and comprehension to support each

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1 student in prekindergarten through third grade.

2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
