A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the list of reading instruments adopted and maintained

- 3 by the commissioner of education.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.006, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (b), (c), (c-1), (c-2), and (c-3) and adding
- 7 Subsections (b-2), (b-3), (b-4), (f-1), and (n) to read as follows:
- 8 (b) The commissioner shall adopt a <u>comprehensive</u> list of
- 9 reading instruments that a school district may use to diagnose
- 10 [student] reading development and comprehension for students who
- 11 are enrolled in kindergarten or in the first, second, or seventh
- 12 grade. For use in diagnosing the reading development and
- 13 comprehension of kindergarten students, the commissioner shall
- 14 adopt $\left[\frac{1}{4}\right]$ multidimensional assessment $\underline{\text{tools}}$ $\left[\frac{\text{tool}}{\text{tool}}\right]$ that $\underline{\text{include}}$
- 15 [includes a] reading instruments that test [instrument and tests]
- 16 at least three developmental skills, including literacy. A
- 17 multidimensional assessment tool administered as provided by this
- 18 subsection is considered to be a reading instrument for purposes of
- 19 this section. A school district [district-level committee
- 20 established under Subchapter F, Chapter 11, may use other [adopt a
- 21 list of reading instruments, [for use in the district in a grade
- 22 level other than kindergarten] in addition to the reading
- 23 instruments included on the commissioner's list. Each reading
- 24 instrument adopted by the commissioner [or a district-level

- 1 committee] must be based on scientific research concerning reading
- 2 skills development and reading comprehension. A list of reading
- 3 instruments adopted under this subsection must provide for
- 4 diagnosing the reading development and comprehension of students
- 5 participating in a program under Subchapter B, Chapter 29.
- 6 (b-2) The commissioner shall include on the list any reading
- 7 <u>instrument that is:</u>
- 8 (1) based on scientific research concerning reading
- 9 skills development and reading comprehension; and
- 10 (2) submitted for inclusion on the list under
- 11 Subsection (b-4).
- 12 (b-3) The commissioner shall annually update the list of
- 13 reading instruments, including multidimensional assessment tools
- 14 authorized under this section.
- 15 (b-4) The commissioner shall provide an online resource
- 16 prominently displayed on the agency's Internet website that
- 17 provides information regarding the list of reading instruments
- 18 maintained by the commissioner under this section and the annual
- 19 process for applying for inclusion on the list, as provided by
- 20 agency rule adopted under Subsection (n).
- 21 (c) Each school district shall administer, at the first and
- 22 second grade levels, a reading instrument that is based on
- 23 scientific research concerning reading skills development and
- 24 reading comprehension [on the list adopted by the commissioner or
- 25 by the district-level committee]. The district shall administer
- 26 the reading instrument in accordance with the commissioner's
- 27 recommendations under Subsection (a)(1).

- 1 (c-1) Each school district shall administer at the
- 2 beginning of the seventh grade a reading instrument [adopted by the
- 3 commissioner] to each student whose performance on the assessment
- 4 instrument in reading administered under Section 39.023(a) to the
- 5 student in grade six did not demonstrate reading proficiency, as
- 6 determined by the commissioner. The district shall administer the
- 7 reading instrument in accordance with the commissioner's
- 8 recommendations under Subsection (a)(1).
- 9 (c-2) Each school district shall administer at the
- 10 kindergarten level a reading instrument [adopted by the
- 11 commissioner under Subsection (b) or approved by the commissioner
- 12 under Subsection (b-1)]. The district shall administer the reading
- 13 instrument in accordance with the commissioner's recommendations
- 14 under Subsection (a)(1).
- 15 (c-3) The commissioner by rule shall determine the
- 16 performance on a [the] reading instrument adopted under Subsection
- 17 (b) that indicates kindergarten readiness.
- 18 (f-1) A reading instrument made available under Subsection
- 19 (f) may not require the purchase of an additional service or
- 20 functionality to have full and complete access to the capabilities
- 21 of the reading instrument.
- 22 <u>(n) The agency by rule shall provide a process for annual</u>
- 23 application for inclusion of a reading instrument on the
- 24 commissioner's list of reading instruments under this section.
- 25 SECTION 2. Section 28.006(b-1), Education Code, is
- 26 repealed.
- 27 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024

- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
