Section 61.001(a), Government Code, is amended 5 to read as follows: 6 Except as provided by Subsection (c), a person who (a) 7 reports for jury service in response to the process of a court is entitled to receive as reimbursement for travel and other expenses 8 9 an amount: not less than \$20 [\$6] for the first day or 10 (1) fraction of the first day the person is in attendance in court in 11 response to the process and discharges the person's duty for that 12 13 day; and 14 (2) not less than \$58 [\$40] for each day or fraction of each day the person is in attendance in court in response to the 15 16 process after the first day and discharges the person's duty for 17 that day. 18 SECTION 2. Section 61.0015(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 19 20 The state shall reimburse a county $\frac{52}{52}$ [$\frac{34}{34}$] a day for (a) 21 the reimbursement paid under Section 61.001 to a person who reports for jury service in response to the process of a court for each day 22 23 or fraction of each day after the first day in attendance in court in response to the process. 24
