A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

3 establishment, massage school, massage therapist, or massage
4 therapy instructor.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section [455.152](#), Occupations Code, is amended to
7 read as follows:

8 Sec. 455.152. INELIGIBILITY FOR LICENSE. A person is not
9 eligible for a license as a massage establishment, massage school,
10 massage therapist, or massage therapy instructor if the person is
11 an individual and has been convicted of, entered a plea of nolo
12 contendere or guilty to, or received deferred adjudication for:

13 (1) an offense under Chapter [20A](#), Section [22.011](#) or
14 [22.021](#) [~~Penal Code~~], or Subchapter [A](#), Chapter [43](#), Penal Code; [~~7~~] or

15 (2) another sexual offense.

16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
