5	SECTION 1. Section 423.0045(c), Government Code, is amended

11	(A) the federal government, the state, or a

- 3 (2) conduct described by Subsection (b) that involves
- 4 a critical infrastructure facility and is committed by:
- 5 (A) an owner or operator of the critical
- 6 infrastructure facility;
- 7 (B) a person under contract with or otherwise
- 8 acting under the direction or on behalf of an owner or operator of
- 9 the critical infrastructure facility;
- 10 (C) a person who has the prior written consent of
- 11 the owner or operator of the critical infrastructure facility; or
- 12 (D) the owner or occupant of the property on
- 13 which the critical infrastructure facility is located or a person

- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 18 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 19 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 20 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 21 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 22 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 23 before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
