- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 51.9197 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 51.9197. MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL STAFFING
- 8 REQUIREMENT. (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Institution of higher education" has the meaning
- 10 assigned by Section 61.003.
- 11 (2) "Mental health professional" has the meaning
- 12 assigned by Section 164.003, Health and Safety Code.
- 13 (b) Each law school at an institution of higher education
- 14 shall ensure that at least one full-time equivalent mental health
- 15 professional is available at the school.
- 16 (c) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall
- 17 adopt rules as necessary to administer this section.
- 18 SECTION 2. Section 51.9197, Education Code, as added by
- 19 this Act, applies beginning with the 2023-2024 academic year.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
