- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 662.085 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 662.085. COVID-19 HEROES AND MEMORIAL DAY. (a) March
- 8 4 is COVID-19 Heroes and Memorial Day in honor of people who lost
- 9 their lives to COVID-19 and in honor of health care workers, first
- 10 responders, and other essential workers who kept working during the
- 11 COVID-19 pandemic so the public could stay safe.
- 12 (b) COVID-19 Heroes and Memorial Day shall be regularly
- 13 <u>observed by appropriate ceremonies and activities.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
