A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the administration by the Texas Department of Housing
- 3 and Community Affairs of a homeless housing and services program
- 4 for youth and young adults.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 2306, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 2306.2586 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 2306.2586. YOUTH AND YOUNG ADULT HOMELESS HOUSING AND
- 9 <u>SERVICES PROGRAM.</u> (a) In this section, "young adult" means an
- 10 <u>individual who is 18 years of age or older but younger than 26 years</u>
- 11 of age.
- 12 (b) The department may administer a youth and young adult
- 13 <u>homeless housing and services grant program to:</u>
- 14 (1) provide for the construction, development, or
- 15 procurement of housing for youth and young adults experiencing
- 16 homelessness;
- 17 (2) provide financial assistance to local providers of
- 18 programs and services to prevent and eliminate homelessness; and
- 19 (3) increase access to safe housing and services for
- 20 youth and young adults across this state.
- 21 <u>(c) The department may adopt rules to govern the program's</u>
- 22 <u>administration</u>, including rules:
- 23 (1) providing for the allocation of any available

- 1 (2) prescribing detailed guidelines on the scope of
- 2 the program.
- 3 (d) The department may use any available money to administer
- 4 the program, including legislative appropriations, appropriation
- 5 transfers from the trusteed programs within the office of the
- 6 governor, available federal money, and any other statutorily
- 7 <u>authorized and appropriate funding sources.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
