- 6 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 191.010, Local Government
- 7 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 191.010. AUTHORITY TO REQUIRE PHOTO IDENTIFICATION TO
- 9 FILE CERTAIN DOCUMENTS [IN CERTAIN COUNTIES].
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 191.010, Local Government Code, is
- 11 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 (b) A county clerk [in a county with a population of 800,000
- 14 or more] may require a person presenting a document in person for
- 15 filing in the real property records of the county to present a photo
- 16 identification to the clerk. The clerk may copy the photo
- 17 identification or record information from the photo
- 18 identification. The clerk may not charge a person a fee to copy or
- 19 record the information from a photo identification.
- 20 (b-1) A county clerk that requires a person to present photo
- 21 identification under Subsection (b) may not accept a document for
- 22 filing in the real property records of the county if the person
- 23 presents the document in person and does not have or refuses to
- 24 provide a photo identification.
