The clerk may not charge a person a fee to copy or 18 record the information from a photo identification. 19 20 (b-1) A county clerk that requires a person to present photo identification under Subsection (b) may not accept a document for 21 filing in the real property records of the county if the person 22

23 presents the document in person and does not have or refuses to

24 provide a photo identification.
