5	SECTION 1. Section 502.198(a), Transportation Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) Except as provided by Sections 502.058, 502.060,
8	502.1911, 502.192, 502.356, [and] 502.357, and 502.360 and
9	Subchapter H, this section applies to all fees collected by a county
10	assessor-collector under this chapter.
11	SECTION 2. Subchapter G, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
12	is amended by adding Section 502.360 to read as follows:
13	Sec. 502.360. ADDITIONAL FEE FOR ELECTRIC VEHICLES. (a) In
14	this section, "electric vehicle" means a motor vehicle that has a
15	gross weight of 10,000 pounds or less and uses electricity as its
16	only source of motor power. The term does not include:
17	(1) an autocycle, as defined by Section 501.008;
18	(2) a moped, as defined by Section 541.201;
19	(3) a motorcycle, as defined by Sections 521.001 and
20	541.201; or
21	(4) a neighborhood electric vehicle, as defined by
22	<u>Section 551.301.</u>
23	(b) In addition to other fees authorized under this chapter,

- 1 registration of an electric vehicle, the applicant shall pay an
- 2 additional fee of:
- 3 (1) \$400, for the registration of a new vehicle to
- 4 which Section 548.102 applies; or
- 5 (2) \$200, for the registration or renewal of
- 6 registration of a vehicle to which Section 548.101 applies.
- 7 (c) Fees collected under this section must be deposited to
- 8 the credit of the state highway fund.
- 9 (d) The department may adopt rules to administer this
- 10 <u>section</u>.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
