8	Sec. 120.121. SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORM DEVELOPED OR PROVIDED
9	BY CERTAIN FOREIGN INDIVIDUALS OR ENTITIES PROHIBITED.
10	Notwithstanding any other law, a social media platform may not
11	operate in this state if the platform is developed or provided by:
12	(1) a governmental entity of China, Iran, North Korea,
13	or Russia;
14	(2) a company or other entity that is:
15	(A) headquartered in China, Iran, North Korea, or
16	Russia;
17	(B) directly or indirectly held or controlled by
18	the government of China, Iran, North Korea, or Russia; or
19	(C) owned by or the majority of stock or other
20	ownership interest of which is held or controlled by individuals
21	who are citizens of China, Iran, North Korea, or Russia;
22	(3) a company or other entity that is owned by or the
23	majority of stock or other ownership interest of which is held or
24	controlled by a company or entity described by Subdivision (2); or

- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
