5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 521.101, Transportation Code, is amended
7	by adding Subsection (n) to read as follows:
8	(n) The department shall adopt procedures to allow a person
9	who is 70 years of age or older and either physically or cognitively
10	incapable of operating a motor vehicle to apply for a personal
11	identification certificate online or by phone if the person
12	surrenders the person's driver's license in a manner prescribed by
13	the department. The procedures:
14	(1) must be in compliance with federal guidelines
15	governing the issuance of identity documents;
16	(2) must require the submission of a written statement
17	from a licensed physician indicating that the person is physically

19 (3) to the extent authorized by federal guidelines

or cognitively incapable of operating a motor vehicle; and

- 20 governing the issuance of identity documents, must require the
- 21 department to use the person's existing driver's license photograph
- 22 on the personal identification certificate unless the person
- 23 requests to use a different photograph.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
