- 6 SECTION 1. Section 316.092(b), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (b) This section expires December 31, 2042 [2034].
- 9 SECTION 2. Sections 316.093(c) and (d), Government Code,
- 10 are amended to read as follows:
- 11 (c) For the purposes of Section 49-q(c-2), Article III,
- 12 Texas Constitution, the comptroller shall adjust the allocation
- 13 provided by Section 49-g(c-1) of that article of amounts to be
- 14 transferred to the fund and to the state highway fund under Section
- 15 49-g(c) of that article in a state fiscal year beginning on or after
- 16 September 1, 2043 [ $\frac{2035}{}$ ], so that the total of those amounts is
- 17 transferred to the economic stabilization fund, except that the
- 18 comptroller shall reduce a transfer made under this subsection as
- 19 necessary to prevent the amount in the fund from exceeding the limit
- 20 in effect for that biennium under Section 49-g(g) of that article.
- 21 (d) Subsections (a) and (b) and this subsection expire
- 22 December 31, 2042 [<del>2034</del>].
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
