- 3 expanding the applicability of an occupational license.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 802.002(8), Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (8) "Dog or cat breeder" means a person who possesses
- 8 five $[\frac{11}{2}]$ or more adult intact female animals and is engaged in the
- 9 business of breeding those animals for direct or indirect sale or
- 10 for exchange in return for consideration [and who sells or
- 11 exchanges, or offers to sell or exchange, not fewer than 20 animals
- 12 in a calendar year].
- SECTION 2. Sections 802.005(a) and (b), Occupations Code,
- 14 are amended to read as follows:
- 15 (a) This section applies only to a dog bred with the intent
- 16 that it be used primarily for:
- 17 (1) herding livestock, as defined by Section 1.003,
- 18 Agriculture Code, or other agricultural uses;
- 19 (2) hunting, including tracking, chasing, pointing,
- 20 flushing, or retrieving game; or
- 21 (3) competing in field trials, hunting tests, breed or
- 22 conformation shows, or similar organized performance events.
- 23 (b) This chapter does not apply to a person to the extent the
- 24 person breeds dogs described by Subsection (a) for personal,

- 1 <u>noncommercial</u> use. A person described by this subsection may
- 2 conduct direct or indirect sales or exchanges in return for
- 3 consideration of dogs described by Subsection (a).
- 4 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 5 of this Act, the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation shall
- 6 prescribe the forms and procedures necessary to implement the
- 7 changes in law made by this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. Notwithstanding Section 802.002(8), Occupations
- 9 Code, as amended by this Act, a dog or cat breeder who possesses
- 10 five or more but fewer than 11 adult intact female animals and is
- 11 engaged in the business of breeding those animals for direct or
- 12 indirect sale or for exchange in return for consideration is not
- 13 required to hold a license under Chapter 802, Occupations Code, to
- 14 act as a dog or cat breeder before January 1, 2024.
- 15 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
