Sections 28.002(h-1) and (h-6), Education Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 7 (h-1) In adopting the essential knowledge and skills for the foundation curriculum under Subsection (a)(1), the State Board of 8 9 Education shall, as appropriate, adopt essential knowledge and skills that develop each student's civic knowledge, including an 10 11 understanding of: 12 (1) the fundamental moral, political, and intellectual foundations of the 13 American experiment in self-government; 14 (2) political ideologies, such as communism and 15 16 totalitarianism, that conflict with the principles of freedom and democracy essential to the founding principles of the United 17 18 States; (3) the history, qualities, traditions, and features 19 of civic engagement in the United States; 20 21 (4) [(3)] the structure, function, and processes of government institutions at the federal, state, and local levels; 22 23 and 24 (5) [(4)] the founding documents of the United States,

1 including:

2 (A) the entirety of the Declaration of 3 Independence; 4 (B) the entirety of the United States 5 Constitution; 6 (C) the Federalist Papers, including the entirety of Essays 10 and 51; 7

8 (D) excerpts from Alexis de Tocqueville's9 Democracy in America;

10 (E) the transcript of the first Lincoln-Douglas
11 debate;

12 (F) the writings of the founding fathers of the13 United States;

14 (G) the entirety of Frederick Douglass's 15 speeches "The Meaning of July Fourth for the Negro" and "What the 16 Black Man Wants"; and

17 (H) the entirety of Martin Luther King Jr.'s18 speech "I Have a Dream."

19 (h-6) In providing instruction regarding the founding 20 documents of the United States as described by Subsection (h-1)(5) 21 [(h-1)(4)], a school district or open-enrollment charter school 22 shall use those documents as part of the instructional materials 23 for the instruction.

24 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024 25 school year.

26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
