- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTIONA1.AASubchapter H, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 151.3132 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 151.3132. FEMININE HYGIENE PRODUCTS. (a) In this
- 8 section, "feminine hygiene product" means a tampon, sanitary
- 9 <u>napkin, menstrual cup, menstrual sponge, menstrual pad, or other</u>
- 10 similar tangible personal property sold for the principal purpose
- 11 of feminine hygiene in connection with the menstrual cycle.
- 12 (b) The sale, use, or consumption of a feminine hygiene
- 13 product is exempted from the taxes imposed by this chapter.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 15 affect taxes imposed before the effective date of this Act, and the
- 16 law in effect before the effective date of this Act is continued in
- 17 effect for purposes of the liability for and collection of those
- 18 taxes.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
