5	SECTION 1. Section 111.004(4), Property Code, is amended to

9	settlor of an intention to create the relationship and which
10	subjects the person holding title to the property to equitable
11	duties to deal with the property:
12	(A) for the benefit of another person; or
13	(B) for a particular purpose, in the case of a
14	trust subject to Subchapter F.
15	SECTION 2. Chapter 112, Property Code, is amended by adding
16	Subchapter F to read as follows:
17	SUBCHAPTER F. NONCHARITABLE TRUST WITHOUT ASCERTAINABLE
18	BENEFICIARY
19	Sec. 112.121. VALIDITY OF TRUST; APPLICABILITY. (a) A
20	trust may be created for a noncharitable purpose without a definite
21	or definitely ascertainable beneficiary. A noncharitable purpose
22	may include seeking economic or noneconomic benefits.
23	(b) This subchapter does not apply to a trust created under
24	<u>Section 112.037.</u>

- 1 Sec. 112.122. ENFORCEMENT OF TRUST. (a) A trust created
- 2 under this subchapter must be enforced by one or more persons
- 3 appointed in the terms of the trust to serve as a trust enforcer.
- 4 (b) A trust enforcer shall enforce the purpose and terms of
- 5 the trust. The trust enforcer is not a beneficiary of the trust,
- 6 but has the rights of a beneficiary provided under this title and
- 7 the common law of this state, or as otherwise provided by the terms
- 8 of the trust.
- 9 (c) A trust enforcer shall exercise any authority granted
- 10 under the terms of the trust or the provisions of this section as a
- 11 fiduciary owing a duty to the trust and is entitled to reasonable
- 12 compensation for serving as trust enforcer.
- 13 (d) A trust enforcer may consent to, waive, object to, or
- 14 petition an appropriate court concerning any matter regarding the
- 15 purpose or administration of the trust.
- (e) Except as otherwise provided by the terms of the trust,
- 17 if more than one person is acting as a trust enforcer, any action in
- 18 that capacity must be decided by the majority vote of the persons
- 19 acting as trust enforcers. If there are an even number of trust
- 20 enforcers and a majority vote cannot be established, the decision
- 21 of the trustee controls.
- 22 <u>(f) The terms of the trust may provide for the succession of</u>
- 23 <u>a trust enforcer or a process of appointing any successor trust</u>
- 24 enforcer.
- 25 (g) If no person is serving as a trust enforcer for a trust
- 26 created under this subchapter, a court properly exercising
- 27 jurisdiction shall appoint one or more persons to serve as the trust

- 2 Sec. 112.123. APPLICATION OR DISTRIBUTION OF TRUST
- 3 PROPERTY. (a) Property of a trust created under this subchapter
- 4 may be applied only to the intended purpose of the trust, except to
- 5 the extent that a court finds that the value of the trust property
- 6 exceeds the amount required for the intended purpose of the trust.
- 7 (b) Except as provided by the terms of the trust, property
- 8 found by a court not to be required for the trust's intended purpose
- 9 shall be distributed:
- 10 (1) as provided by the terms of the trust; or
- 11 (2) if the trust does not provide for the distribution
- 12 of such property, to the settlor if then living or to the settlor's
- 13 successors in interest.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter F, Chapter 112, Property Code, as
- 15 added by this Act, applies only to a trust created on or after the
- 16 effective date of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
