| 10 | (b) On request of a peace officer who is a parent of or |
| 11 | person standing in parental relation to a student, the board of |
| 12 | trustees of a school district or the board's designee shall |
| 13 | transfer the student to another district campus or to another |
| 14 | school district under an agreement under Section 25.035. |
| 15 | (c) A transfer under this section must be to the campus or |
| 16 | school district, as applicable, selected by the peace officer |
| 17 | making the request. |
| 18 | (d) A school district is not required to provide |
| 19 | transportation to a student who transfers to another campus or |
| 20 | school district under this section. |
| 21 | SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024 |
| 22 | school year. |
| 23 | SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives |
| 24 | a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as |

provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
