1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to memoranda of understanding between the Texas Water
1-20 Development Board and other state agencies.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 6.104, Water Code, is amended to read as
1-23 follows:

1-24 Sec. 6.104. MEMORANDA OF UNDERSTANDING. The board may
1-25 enter into a memorandum of understanding with any other state
1-26 agency [~~and shall adopt by rule any memorandum of understanding~~
1-27 ~~between the board and any other state agency~~].

1-28 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
1-29 6.104, Water Code, applies only to a memorandum of understanding
1-30 that is entered into on or after the effective date of this Act. A
1-31 memorandum of understanding that is entered into before that date
1-32 is governed by the law in effect on the date the memorandum of
1-33 understanding was entered into, and the former law is continued in
1-34 effect for that purpose.

1-35 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
