- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 341, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsection 341.0645 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 341.0645. POOL SAFETY. (a) An owner, manager,
- 8 operator, or other attendant in charge of a public swimming pool,
- 9 wading pool, baby pool, hot tub, in-ground spa, water park, spray
- 10 fountain, or other artificial body of water typically used for
- 11 recreational swimming, bathing, or play shall comply with relevant
- 12 pool safety standards adopted under this section.
- 13 (b) The executive commissioner shall adopt by rule pool
- 14 safety standards necessary to prevent drowning. The standards
- 15 must:
- 16 (1) be at least as stringent as those imposed under the
- 17 federal Virginia Graeme Baker Pool and Spa Safety Act (15 U.S.C.
- 18 Section 8001 et seq.); and
- 19 (2) comply with and adopt by reference a version of the
- 20 International Swimming Pool and Spa Code, as defined by Section
- 21 214.103, Local Government Code, that is not older than the version
- 22 in effect on May 1, 2019, regarding all construction, alteration,
- 23 renovation, enlargement, and repair of commercial swimming pools
- 24 and spas.

- 1 (c) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), the department is not
- 2 required to adopt Chapter 1 of the International Swimming Pool and
- 3 Spa Code.
- 4 (d) Subsection (b) does not affect requirements for pool
- 5 yard enclosure imposed under Chapter 757.
- 6 (e) The executive commissioner by rule shall authorize a
- 7 minor addition, alteration, renovation, or repair to an existing
- 8 pool or spa and related mechanical, electrical, and plumbing
- 9 systems in the same manner and arrangement as the executive
- 10 commissioner authorized the construction of the pool or spa and
- 11 related mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems.
- 12 (f) A person may use, maintain, and repair a pool or spa that
- 13 was in compliance with the laws of this state on August 31, 2021,
- 14 and related mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems in
- 15 accordance with the laws applicable to the pool or system on that
- 16 date.
- 17 (g) Notwithstanding Subsection (b)(2), this section does
- 18 not affect the authority of the executive commissioner to adopt
- 19 rules regarding pool operation and management, water quality,
- 20 safety standards unrelated to design and construction, signage, and
- 21 enclosures.
- 22 (h) The executive commissioner by rule shall require pool
- 23 and spa inspectors to obtain training and certification in the
- 24 operation of pools and spas that is at least equivalent to the
- 25 training and certification requirements of pool and spa operators.
- 26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
