- 5 SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 10, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Chapter 2278 to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 2278. PROHIBITION ON CONTRACTS WITH CHINESE COMPANIES
- 8 Sec. 2278.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
- 9 <u>(1) "Chinese company" means a company that is</u>
- 10 <u>headquartered</u> in China or is a wholly owned subsidiary or
- 11 majority-owned subsidiary of a company headquartered in China,
- 12 regardless of whether:

- (A) the company's or its parent company's
- 14 securities are publicly traded; or
- 15 (B) the company or its parent company is listed
- 16 as a Chinese company on a public stock exchange.
- 17 (2) "Governmental entity" means a state agency or
- 18 political subdivision of this state.
- 19 Sec. 2278.002. PROVISION REQUIRED IN CONTRACT. A
- 20 governmental entity may not enter into a contract with a company for
- 21 goods or services unless the contract contains a written
- 22 verification from the company that it is not a Chinese company.
- SECTION 2. Section 2278.002, Government Code, as added by
- 24 this Act, applies only to a contract entered into on or after

- 1 January 1, 2024. A contract entered into before that date is
- 2 governed by the law in effect on the date the contract was entered
- 3 into, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
