- 2 relating to disclosure of certain complaint and investigation
- 3 information by the Texas State Board of Pharmacy to the United
- 4 States Food and Drug Administration.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 555.010, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 555.010. CONFIDENTIALITY; AUTHORIZED DISCLOSURE. (a)
- 9 Subject to Subsection (b), the $[\frac{The}{T}]$ identity of a person who
- 10 reports to or assists the board under Section 555.002(c) and a
- 11 document that could disclose the identity of that person are
- 12 confidential and are not considered public information for the
- 13 purposes of Chapter 552, Government Code.
- 14 (b) The identity of a person described by Subsection (a) and
- 15 a document that could disclose the identity of that person may be
- 16 disclosed to the United States Food and Drug Administration under a
- 17 memorandum of understanding described by Section 503A, Federal
- 18 Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. Section 353a(b)(3)(B)),
- 19 entered into as provided by that section.
- SECTION 2. Section 565.055(c), Occupations Code, is amended
- 21 to read as follows:
- (c) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), information or material
- 23 compiled by the board in connection with an investigation may be
- 24 disclosed:

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- 1 (1) during any proceeding conducted by the State
- 2 Office of Administrative Hearings, to the board, or a panel of the
- 3 board, or in a subsequent trial or appeal of a board action or
- 4 order;
- 5 (2) to a person providing a service to the board,
- 6 including an expert witness, investigator, or employee of an entity
- 7 that contracts with the board, related to a disciplinary proceeding
- 8 against an applicant or license holder, or a subsequent trial or
- 9 appeal, if the information is necessary for preparation for, or a
- 10 presentation in, the proceeding;
- 11 (3) to an entity in another jurisdiction that:
- 12 (A) licenses or disciplines pharmacists or
- 13 pharmacies; or
- 14 (B) registers or disciplines pharmacy
- 15 technicians or pharmacy technician trainees;
- 16 (4) to a pharmaceutical or pharmacy peer review
- 17 committee as described under Chapter 564;
- 18 (5) to a law enforcement agency;
- 19 (6) to a person engaged in bona fide research, if all
- 20 information identifying a specific individual has been deleted;
- 21 [or]
- 22 (7) to an entity that administers a board-approved
- 23 pharmacy technician certification examination; or
- 24 (8) to the United States Food and Drug Administration
- 25 under a memorandum of understanding described by Section 503A,
- 26 Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. Section
- 27 353a(b)(3)(B)), entered into as provided by that section.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
