4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 403, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 403.0306 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 403.0306. COMMISSIONED PEACE OFFICERS. The
8	comptroller shall ensure that a security officer or investigator
9	commissioned as a peace officer by the comptroller is compensated
10	according to Schedule C of the position classification salary
11	schedule prescribed by the General Appropriations Act.
12	SECTION 2. Section 661.918(a), Government Code, is amended
13	to read as follows:
14	(a) This section applies to a peace officer under Article
15	2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, who is commissioned as a law
16	enforcement officer or agent, including a ranger, by:
17	(1) the Public Safety Commission and the director of
18	the Department of Public Safety;
19	(2) the Parks and Wildlife Commission;
20	(3) the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission;
21	(4) the attorney general; [or]
22	(5) the insurance fraud unit of the Texas Department
23	of Insurance <u>; or</u>
24	(6) the comptroller.

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1 SECTION 3. (a) The classification officer in the office of 2 the state auditor shall classify the position of security officer 3 or investigator commissioned as a peace officer by the comptroller 4 as a Schedule C position under the Texas Position Classification 5 Plan.

6 (b) The change made by the classification officer as 7 required by this section applies beginning with the state fiscal 8 biennium beginning September 1, 2023.

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(c) This section expires September 1, 2025.

10 SECTION 4. Section 661.918(a), Government Code, as amended 11 by this Act, applies only to an injury that occurs on or after the 12 effective date of this Act.

13 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
