- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 17.004, Utilities Code, is amended by 6 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (a-1) Not later than three hours after an electric utility
- 8 intentionally shuts off electric power to a customer in response to
- 9 an emergency event, the utility, or the customer's retail electric
- 10 provider, as appropriate, shall notify the customer of the shutoff
- 11 by e-mail or text message. The notice must include the following
- 12 <u>information:</u>

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- 13 (1) the estimated time and date that the utility will
- 14 restore electric power to the customer; and
- 15 (2) whether the shutoff is part of an involuntary load
- 16 shedding event.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 17.005, Utilities Code, is amended by
- 18 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 19 <u>(g) Not later than three hours after a municipally owned</u>
- 20 utility intentionally shuts off electric power to a customer in
- 21 response to an emergency event, the utility shall notify the
- 22 customer of the shutoff by e-mail or text message. The notice must
- 23 include the following information:
- 24 (1) the estimated time and date that the utility will

- 1 restore electric power to the customer; and
- 2 (2) whether the shutoff is part of an involuntary load
- 3 shedding event.
- 4 SECTION 3. Section 17.006, Utilities Code, is amended by
- 5 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 6 (g) Not later than three hours after an electric cooperative
- 7 intentionally shuts off electric power to a customer in response to
- 8 an emergency event, the utility shall notify the customer of the
- 9 shutoff by e-mail or text message. The notice must include the
- 10 <u>following information:</u>
- 11 (1) the estimated time and date that the utility will
- 12 restore electric power to the customer; and
- (2) whether the shutoff is part of an involuntary load
- 14 shedding event.
- SECTION 4. Subchapter E, Chapter 13, Water Code, is amended
- 16 by adding Section 13.1397 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 13.1397. NOTICE REQUIRED FOR INTENTIONAL SHUTOFF OF
- 18 SERVICE. Not later than three hours after a retail public utility
- 19 intentionally shuts off water service to a customer in response to
- 20 an emergency event, the utility shall notify the customer of the
- 21 shutoff by e-mail or text message. The notice must include the
- 22 estimated time and date that the utility will restore water service
- 23 to the customer.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
