(a) A license 1 holder shall complete six hours of suicide prevention training 2 approved by the Health and Human Services Commission under Section 3 531.0412, Government Code, in the six years preceding the date the 4 5 license holder applies for renewal. 6 (b) The executive council may not renew the license of a license holder who does not complete the training required by this 7 8 section. 9 (c) A license holder may complete the training required by 10 this section: (1) as part of any continuing education required by 11 12 the executive council under Section 507.157; and (2) in more than one training session. 13 SECTION 11. Not later than December 1, 2023, the Health and 14 15 Human Services Commission shall approve suicide prevention training courses as required by Section 531.0412, Government Code, 16 17 as added by this Act. SECTION 12. The changes in law made by this Act apply only 18 to the renewal of a license or registration permit on or after 19 January 1, 2025. 20 21 SECTION 13. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
