## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to a study on the disparities in the provision of certain

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. (a) In this Act, "commission" means the Health
- 7 and Human Services Commission.
- 8 (b) The commission, in collaboration with nonprofit
- 9 organizations with experience providing health care resources or
- 10 services to Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders, shall conduct a
- 11 study on the disparities in health care services provided to Asian
- 12 Americans and Pacific Islanders, including disparities in:
- 13 (1) the provision of mental health services;
- 14 (2) the provision of reproductive health care
- 15 services;
- 16 (3) the provision of health care services due to
- 17 violence against an individual based on the individual's actual or
- 18 perceived sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender
- 19 expression;
- 20 (4) the provision of health care services due to
- 21 gender-based violence;
- 22 (5) provision of gender-affirming health care
- 23 services; and
- 24 (6) the availability of language interpreters in

- 1 health care settings.
- 2 (c) In conducting the study, the commission shall solicit
- 3 and consider information from:
- 4 (1) the Department of State Health Services;
- 5 (2) the Center for Elimination of Disproportionality
- 6 and Disparities;
- 7 (3) the Texas Education Agency; and
- 8 (4) other state agencies, political subdivisions, or
- 9 nonprofit organizations as necessary.
- 10 (d) The commission shall ensure the information collected
- 11 under Subsection (c) of this section does not personally identify a
- 12 patient and must disaggregate the data by ethnicity.
- 13 (e) Not later than December 1, 2024, the commission shall
- 14 prepare and submit to the legislature a written report containing
- 15 the results of the study and any recommendations for legislative
- 16 action.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act expires September 1, 2025.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
