- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. In this Act:
- 6 (1) "Board" means the State Soil and Water
- 7 Conservation Board.
- 8 (2) "Carrizo cane" means the invasive species of giant
- 9 reed with the scientific name Arundo donax.
- 10 (3) "Program" means the carrizo cane eradication
- 11 program under Section 201.0225, Agriculture Code.
- 12 SECTION 2. CARRIZO CANE STUDY. (a) The board shall conduct
- 13 a study of the extent of the growth of carrizo cane along the Rio
- 14 Grande to assist the board in administering the program.
- 15 (b) In conducting the study, the board shall determine:
- 16 (1) the acreage of carrizo cane remaining along the
- 17 Rio Grande;
- 18 (2) the amount of water that is consumed by the growth
- 19 of carrizo cane along the Rio Grande; and
- 20 (3) the program's cost of eradicating the carrizo cane
