A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to requirements for notice advertising the sale of property to enforce a self-service storage facility lien. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Sections 59.042(b) and (c), Property Code, are 5 amended to read as follows: 6 (b) If the tenant fails to satisfy the claim on or before the 7 14th day after the date the notice is delivered, the lessor must 8 publish or post notices advertising the sale or otherwise give 9 notice advertising the sale in a commercially reasonable manner as 10 11 provided by this subchapter. 12 (c) The [If notice is by publication, the] lessor may not 13 sell the property until: 14 (1) the 15th day after the date the notice advertising the sale is first published, if the notice is by publication; 15 (2) [. If notice is by posting, the lessor may sell 16 the property after] the 10th day after the date the notices 17 advertising the sale are posted, if the notice is by posting; or 18 19 (3) the 10th day after the date the notice is given, if the notice is given in a commercially reasonable manner. 20 21 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 59.044, Property Code, is 22 amended to read as follows: Sec. 59.044. METHOD AND CONTENT OF NOTICE ADVERTISING [OF] 23 SALE. 24

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1 SECTION 3. Section 59.044, Property Code, is amended by 2 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read 3 as follows:

4 (b) The lessor must <u>either:</u> 5 (1) publish the notice advertising the sale: 6 (A) subject to Subsection (c), [once in each of 7 two consecutive weeks] in a newspaper of general circulation in the 8 county in which the self-service storage facility is located; or (B) on a publicly accessible Internet website 9 that regularly advertises or conducts auctions of personal 10 property; or 11 12 (2) give notice advertising the sale in a commercially 13 reasonable manner. 14 (c) If there is not a newspaper of general circulation in 15 the county in which to publish notice advertising the sale under Subsection (b)(1), the lessor may [instead] post a copy of the 16 17 notice at the self-service storage facility and at least five other conspicuous locations near the facility. 18 19 (d) For purposes of this section, notice advertising a sale is considered to be given in a commercially reasonable manner if at 20 least three independent bidders register for, view, or attend the 21 sale, regardless of whether the sale is conducted at the 22 self-service storage facility or a reasonably near public place or 23 24 through an Internet website accessible to the public. 25 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act to Chapter

26 59, Property Code, apply only to a self-service storage facility 27 rental agreement entered into, extended, or renewed on or after the

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effective date of this Act. A self-service storage facility rental agreement entered into, extended, or renewed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

6 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
