- 2 relating to postage for early voting ballots voted by mail.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 86.002, Election Code, is amended by
- 5 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 6 (a-1) The officially prescribed carrier envelope shall be
- 7 prepared so that it can be mailed free of United States postage. The
- 8 secretary of state shall adopt rules necessary for the
- 9 administration of this subsection.
- SECTION 2. Section 86.013(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 (a) "Carrier Envelope for Early Voting Ballot," the name and
- 13 official title of the early voting clerk as addressee, [and] the
- 14 clerk's official mailing address, and an indication that return
- 15 postage for the envelope and balloting materials is prepaid must be
- 16 printed on the face of each official carrier envelope for a ballot
- 17 to be voted by mail.
- SECTION 3. Section 86.002(e), Election Code, is repealed.
- 19 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 to an election ordered on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 21 An election ordered before the effective date of this Act is
- 22 governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective
- 23 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 24 purpose.
