A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a study on certain declines in minority participation
3	at public institutions of higher education.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 61.0811 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 61.0811. STUDY AND REPORT ON CERTAIN DECLINES IN
8	MINORITY PARTICIPATION. (a) If the board collects data under
9	Section 61.080 indicating that an institution of higher education
10	has experienced a decline in applications, admissions, or retention
11	by members of a particular racial or ethnic minority group for each
12	of the three preceding academic years, the board shall conduct a
13	study to determine the reasons for the decline at the institution.
14	(b) The study must include a review of:
15	(1) the institution of higher education's recruitment
16	and outreach programs for members of the racial or ethnic minority
17	group; and
18	(2) any financial, academic, or other obstacles to
19	enrollment or attendance at the institution faced by prospective or
20	current students who are members of the racial or ethnic minority
21	group.
22	(c) Not later than September 1 of each year, the board shall
23	<pre>submit:</pre>
24	(1) to the legislature a report on the results of each

- 1 study conducted under this section during the preceding year that
- 2 includes any recommendations for legislative or other action to
- 3 increase participation in public higher education by members of the
- 4 racial or ethnic minority groups considered by those studies; and
- 5 (2) to the governing board of each institution of
- 6 higher education for which the board conducted a study under this
- 7 section during the preceding year a report on the results of the
- 8 study that includes any recommendations for changes to institution
- 9 policies or procedures or for other action to increase
- 10 participation by members of the racial or ethnic minority group at
- 11 the institution.
- 12 (d) The board shall adopt rules as necessary to implement
- 13 this section.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 61.0811, Education Code, as added by
- 15 this Act, applies beginning with data collected on minority
- 16 participation in public higher education for the 2023-2024 academic
- 17 year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
