- CERTAIN INCLUSIVITY POLICIES. A school district or open-enrollment 8
- 9 charter school may not discipline, retaliate against, or otherwise
- discriminate against a district or school employee who, because of 10
- the employee's sincerely held religious beliefs, refuses to: 11
- 12 (1) complete the LGBTQ Inclusivity in Schools: A
- Self-Assessment Tool published by the Centers for Disease Control 13
- 14 and Prevention; or

- (2) implement a district or school policy based on a 15
- 16 recommendation provided by that publication.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 17
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 18
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 19
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 21
