- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 38.040 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 38.040. CUSTODIAN WORKLOAD POLICY. (a) The board of
- 7 trustees of each school district shall adopt a policy regarding
- 8 custodian workload for district facilities. The policy must
- 9 establish benchmarks for the amount of square feet that may be
- 10 assigned to a properly equipped school custodian for maintenance
- 11 and custodial services during an eight-hour shift.
- 12 (b) The board must provide benchmarks under Subsection (a)
- 13 categorized by elementary, middle, and high school campuses, and
- 14 other district facilities.
- 15 (c) The school district shall post the policy adopted under
- 16 this section on the school district's Internet website.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 18 school year.

- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
