- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 490I.0103(c), Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) This chapter does not grant the comptroller authority to
- 8 regulate broadband services or broadband service providers or,
- 9 except as required of an applicant or recipient under Section
- 10 490I.0106, to require broadband service providers to:
- 11 (1) submit information to the comptroller; or
- 12 (2) comply with best practices for broadband
- 13 <u>development</u>.
- SECTION 2. Sections 4901.0106(b) and (h), Government Code,
- 15 are amended to read as follows:
- 16 (b) The office shall establish and publish criteria for
- 17 making awards under Subsection (a). The office shall:
- 18 (1) take into consideration grants and other financial
- 19 incentives awarded by the federal government for the deployment of
- 20 broadband service in a designated area;
- 21 (2) prioritize the applications of applicants that
- 22 will expand access to and adoption of broadband service in eligible
- 23 areas in which the lowest percentage of addresses have access to
- 24 broadband service; [and]

- 1 (3) prioritize the applications of applicants that
- 2 will expand access to broadband service in public and private
- 3 primary and secondary schools and institutions of higher education;
- 4 and
- 5 (4) develop best practices for broadband development
- 6 and provide the manner in which award recipients must comply with
- 7 those best practices.
- 8 (h) The office shall establish and publish criteria for
- 9 award recipients. The criteria must include requirements that
- 10 grants, loans, and other financial incentives awarded through the
- 11 program be used only:
- 12 (1) for capital expenses, purchase or lease of
- 13 property, and other expenses, including backhaul and transport,
- 14 that will facilitate the provision or adoption of broadband
- 15 service; and
- 16 (2) in the manner provided by the office for
- 17 compliance with the best practices for broadband development
- 18 developed under Subsection (b)(4).
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 490I.0106, Government Code, as amended
- 20 by this Act, applies only to an application submitted to the
- 21 broadband development office on or after the date the office
- 22 publishes the best practices for broadband development as provided
- 23 by that section.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
