A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to staff member requirements for high quality prekindergarten programs. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 29.167, Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 29.167. HIGH QUALITY CURRICULUM AND <u>STAFF</u> [TEACHER] REQUIREMENTS. 8 SECTION 2. Sections 29.167(b) and (d), Education Code, are 9 amended to read as follows: 10 11 (b) Each prekindergarten program staff member [teacher for 12 a prekindergarten program class] must meet the following requirements, as applicable: 13 14 (1) for a prekindergarten program supervisor, be certified under Subchapter B, Chapter 21; and 15 for a prekindergarten teacher, have one of the 16 (2) following [additional] qualifications: 17 18 (A) a Child Development Associate (CDA) credential or another early childhood education credential 19 20 approved by the agency; 21 (B) certification offered through a training 22 center accredited by Association Montessori Internationale or 23 through the Montessori Accreditation Council for Teacher 24 Education;

H.B. No. 2729 (C) at least eight years' experience of teaching in a nationally accredited child care program;

3 (D) be employed as a prekindergarten teacher in a 4 school district that has received approval from the commissioner 5 for the district's prekindergarten-specific instructional training 6 plan that the teacher uses in the teacher's prekindergarten 7 classroom; or

(E) an equivalent qualification.

9 (d) A school district <u>or an entity with which the district</u> 10 <u>contracts to provide a prekindergarten program</u> must attempt to 11 maintain an average ratio in any prekindergarten program class of 12 not less than one certified teacher or teacher's aide for each 11 13 students.

SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024 school year.

16 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
