- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 109.205(c), Education Code, is repealed.
- 6 SECTION 2. (a) In this section, "consortium" means the
- 7 Texas Produced Water Consortium established by Subchapter E,
- 8 Chapter 109, Education Code.
- 9 (b) Not later than October 1, 2023, the consortium shall
- 10 select a pilot project or program for consideration and
- 11 implementation.
- 12 (c) Not later than October 1, 2024, the consortium shall
- 13 submit to the legislature a report regarding:
- 14 (1) the status of the pilot project or program
- 15 selected under Subsection (b) of this section; and
- 16 (2) any suggested policy, regulatory, or legislative
- 17 changes resulting from an analysis of the implementation of the
- 18 pilot project or program selected under Subsection (b) of this
- 19 section.
- 20 (d) The consortium is required to implement a provision of
- 21 this section only if the legislature appropriates money
- 22 specifically for that purpose. If the legislature does not
- 23 appropriate money specifically for that purpose, the consortium
- 24 may, but is not required to, implement the provision using other

- 1 money available to the consortium for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
