## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the amendment of an existing comprehensive development

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 5 SECTION 1. Section 223.208, Transportation Code, is amended 6 by adding Subsections (i) and (j) to read as follows:
- (i) Not later than September 1, 2024, and notwithstanding

  8 Subsection (h), the department shall amend a comprehensive

  9 development agreement entered into on or before March 22, 2007, for

  10 State Highway 130 from U.S. Highway 183 to Interstate Highway 10

  11 (Segments 5 and 6) to extend the term of the agreement for up to 20
- 12 <u>additional years if the amendment:</u>
- 13 <u>(1) outlines the benefit the state will derive from</u>
  14 extending the term; and
- (2) requires the private participant to provide funds
  to the department not later than December 31, 2024, in an amount
  agreed to by the department and the private participant in
  accordance with the requirements of the amendment.
- (j) The funds received under Subsection (i)(2) must be used
  by the department, or on behalf of the department using the
  department's procurement process, for the design, financing, and
  construction of a nontolled connector between Interstate Highway 35
  and State Highway 130 to be located wholly or partly in a county in
  which the project that is the subject of the comprehensive

- 1 <u>development agreement described by Subsection (i) is located. The</u>
- 2 connector shall be owned by the department.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
