- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 171, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 171.009 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 171.009. RESTRICTION ON COMPANY'S FACILITATION OF
- 8 TRAVEL TO OBTAIN ABORTION OUTSIDE THIS STATE. (a) In this section,
- 9 "governing person" has the meaning assigned by Section 1.002,
- 10 Business Organizations Code.
- 11 (b) A governing person of a company doing business in this
- 12 state who facilitates travel of an employee of the company outside
- 13 of this state to obtain an abortion is considered in breach of the
- 14 person's fiduciary duty to the company.
- 15 (c) The company, the company's shareholders, or another
- 16 aggrieved person may bring any action or derivative action
- 17 available under the laws of this state against the governing person
- 18 for breach of the fiduciary duty described by Subsection (b).
- 19 (d) The business judgment rule is not a defense to liability
- 20 in an action brought under this section.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 171.009, Health and Safety Code, as
- 22 added by this Act, applies only to conduct that occurs on or after
- 23 the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
