A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to minimum compensation for inmates participating in

- 3 certain work programs.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 497.004(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The board \underline{shall} [may] develop by rule and the department
- 8 shall [may] administer an incentive pay scale for work program
- 9 participants consistent with rules adopted by the board under
- 10 Subchapter C. The board shall set pay levels at a minimum of \$5.25
- 11 per hour of work. Prison industries may be financed through
- 12 contributions donated for this purpose by private businesses
- 13 contracting with the department. The department shall apportion
- 14 pay earned by a work program participant in the same manner as is
- 15 required by rules adopted by the board under Section 497.0581.
- SECTION 2. Section 497.099(b), Government Code, is amended
- 17 to read as follows:
- (b) The board $\frac{\text{shall}}{\text{may}}$ develop by rule and the department
- 19 <u>shall</u> [may] administer an incentive pay scale program for inmates
- 20 required to work in agricultural, industrial, or other work
- 21 programs. In developing the program, the board shall set pay levels
- 22 not to unjustly reward inmates, but rather to instruct inmates on
- 23 the virtues of diligent participation in the workplace, provided
- 24 that the board shall set pay levels at a minimum of \$5.25 per hour of

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- 1 work. The department shall deposit an amount earned by an inmate
- 2 under this subsection into the inmate's trust fund and may deduct
- 3 not more than 80 percent of the amount deposited under this
- 4 subsection for payment of restitution and dependent care owed by
- 5 the inmate. This subsection does not apply to the compensation of
- 6 an inmate participating in a Texas Correctional Industries program
- 7 under Subchapter A or an inmate participating in a private sector
- 8 prison industries program under Subchapter C.
- 9 SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2023, the Texas Board
- 10 of Criminal Justice shall adopt the rules required by Sections
- 497.004(a) and 497.099(b), Government Code, as amended by this Act.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
