- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 282, Acts of the 51st Legislature,
- 6 Regular Session, 1949, is amended by adding Sections 1a and 11a to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 1a. The District has all the rights, powers,
- 9 privileges, functions, and duties provided by the general law of
- 10 this state applicable to a conservation, reclamation, and drainage
- 11 district created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution,
- 12 <u>including Chapters 49 and 56, Water Code.</u>
- Sec. 11a. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 14 section, the District may only use funds generated by ad valorem
- 15 taxes:
- 16 (1) for flood and drainage mitigation in the District;
- 17 <u>and</u>
- 18 (2) to pay for the administrative costs of the
- 19 District.
- 20 (b) The District may not commingle funds generated by ad
- 21 valorem taxes with funds used for freshwater distribution or
- 22 sanitary sewer collection services.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
