A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the enforcement of commercial motor vehicle safety 3 standards in certain municipalities. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 644.101(b), Transportation Code, 5 is amended to read as follows: 6 A police officer of any of the following municipalities 7 (b) is eligible to apply for certification under this section: 8 9 (1) a municipality with a population of 50,000 or 10 more; a municipality with a population of 25,000 or more 11 (2) 12 any part of which is located in a county with a population of 500,000 or more; 13 14 (3) a municipality with a population of less than 25,000: 15 any part of which is located in a county with 16 (A) a population of 3.3 million; and 17 18 (B) that contains or adjacent is to an international port; 19 (4) a municipality with a population of at least 20 34,000 that is located in a county that borders two or more states; 21 22 (5) a municipality any part of which is located in a 23 county bordering the United Mexican States; 24 (6) a municipality with a population of less than

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1 population of more than 1.2 million; and 2 (C) contains two highways that are part of the 3 national system of interstate and defense highways; 4 (12) a municipality with a population of more than 5 3,000 and less than 10,000 that: 6 (A) contains a highway that is part of the 7 national system of interstate and defense highways; and 8 (B) is located in a county with a population between 150,000 and 155,000; 9 (13) a municipality with a population of less than 10 75,000 that is located in three counties, at least one of which has 11 12 a population greater than 3.3 million; a municipality with a population between 14,000 13 (14) and 17,000 that: 14 contains three or more numbered United States 15 (A) 16 highways; and 17 (B) is located in a county that is adjacent to a county with a population of more than 200,000; [or] 18 19 (15) a municipality with a population of less than 50,000 that is located in: 20 21 (A) a county that generated \$20 million or more in tax revenue collected under Chapters 201 and 202, Tax Code, from 22 23 oil and gas production during the preceding state fiscal year; or 24 (B) a county that is adjacent to two or more 25 counties described by Paragraph (A); or (16) a municipality with a population of more than 26 27 2,000 that is located in a county:

2		(B)	that borders:
3			(i) another state; and
4			(ii) the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway.
5	SECTION 2.	Thi	s Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
