- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 21.047(a) and (d), Property Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Special commissioners may adjudge the costs of an
- 8 eminent domain proceeding against any party. If the commissioners
- 9 award greater damages than the condemnor offered to pay before the
- 10 proceedings began or if the decision of the commissioners is
- 11 appealed and a court awards greater damages than the commissioners
- 12 awarded, the condemnor shall pay all costs, expenses, and fees
- 13 <u>incurred by the property owner</u>. If the commissioners' award or the
- 14 court's determination of the damages is less than or equal to the
- 15 amount the condemnor offered before proceedings began, the property
- 16 owner shall pay the costs.
- 17 (d) If a court hearing a suit under this chapter determines
- 18 that a condemnor did not make a bona fide offer to acquire the
- 19 property from the property owner voluntarily as required by Section
- 20 21.0113, the court shall abate the suit, order the condemnor to make
- 21 a bona fide offer, and order the condemnor to pay:
- 22 (1) all costs, expenses, and fees incurred by the
- 23 property owner as provided by Subsection (a); and
- 24 (2) any reasonable attorney's fees and other

- 1 professional fees incurred by the property owner that are directly
- 2 related to the violation.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 21.047, Property Code, as amended by
- 4 this Act, applies only to an eminent domain proceeding commenced on
- 5 or after the effective date of this Act. An eminent domain
- 6 proceeding commenced before the effective date of this Act is
- 7 governed by the law applicable to the proceeding immediately before
- 8 the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect
- 9 for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
